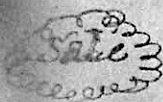

This Indenture made on the eighth day of April in the year of our Lord  
 one thousand eight hundred and fourteen Between Elington R. Browne  
 and Ann M. Browne his wife of the County of Fauquier & state of  
 Virginia of the first part and Clements Rochelle of the County of Southamp-  
 ton and state aforesaid of the second part Witnesseth that the said  
 Elington R. Browne and Ann M. his wife in and for the consideration  
 of the sum of two thousand one hundred and seventy five dollars  
 current money of Virginia cash in hand paid them by the said Cle-  
 ments Rochelle the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge they  
 the said Elington R. Browne and Ann M. his wife have granted  
 and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto him  
 the said Clements Rochelle to him and his heirs forever a certain  
 piece tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of
