 we do therefore command you that you do personally go to the said
 Lelia Whitehead and receive her acknowledgment of the same and
 examine her privately and apart from the said Joseph B Whitehead
 her husband whether she doth the same freely and voluntarily without
 her persuasion or threats and whether she be willing that the same should
 be recorded in our County Court of Southampton officers and when you
 have received her acknowledgment and examined her as aforesaid and when you
 are satisfied and openly certify us thereof in our said County Court
 under your seals ending then there the said Indenture and this
 with Writings James Rockells clerk of our said Court at his office
 the day of June 1816 and 40th year of the Commonwealth
 Virginia
