This Indenture made this 31st day of May in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixteen between Jonathan Luter of the County of Southampton John Laurence of the County of Solihull & Abraham Cope of the County of Southampton Withethat that Whereas the said Abraham Cope hath executed a deed of trust to the said John Luter for a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton containing one hundred and eighty acres more or less to secure the payment of a debt of two hundred and twenty five dollars eighty six and 2/3 cents due to the said John Laurence which said debt was executed by the said Abraham Cope on the 19th day of July 1815 and was recorded in the County Court of Southampton on the 21st day of August 1815 - Now know ye to whom these presents may ever concern that we Jonathan Luter and John Laurence doth acknowledge ourselves to be fully satisfied for the said debt of trust having received of the above named Abraham Cope the above mentioned sum of two hundred and fifty dollars 86 & 2/3 Cents with interest thereon from the said 19th of July 1815 until the above named 31st day of May 1816 and we the said Jonathan Luter and John Laurence doth for ourselves our and each of our heirs executors admors to release and relinquish all our rights titles interests claims or demands or what nature or kind soever to the said tract or parcel of land before mentioned to the said Abraham Cope to his heirs or assigns forever In Witness whereof we the said Jonathan Luter and John Laurence doth hereunto set our hands & affix our seals the day and date first above mentioned
