P. Sharp and Jane Sharp his wife for and in consideration of the sum
of sixty pounds Current money of Virginia to him in hand paid by
the said William J. Moore all and before the enrolling and delivery of
of these presents the receipt whereof do hereby acknowledge & be
the said Benjamin P. Sharp and Jane Sharp his wife both given
granted bargained and sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents
doth grant bargain and sell alien and confirm unto the said William
J. Moore his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying
and being in the County of Southampton and state of Virginia in the
Angelica swamp adjoining the lands of Frank Ridley & others it
being all that tract of land bequeathed by Timothy Sharp dec'd in his
last will and testament of John Person son of William and with
said Benjamin P. Sharp and Jane his wife doth relinquish all our
right title or interest to the above mentioned land without liability
or responsibility as to us or our heirs forever it is expressly understood
by the covenanting parties to these presents that the said Benjamin
P. Sharp and Jane Sharp his wife does not intend to make a
general Warranty as to the above mentioned land but to warrant
and defend against themselves and heirs or any other person or persons
whatsoever claiming under them given under our hands & seals
this day and year above written.

to you or any two or more of your power to receive the acknowledgment
which the said Jane Sharp shall be willing to make before you of the
Conveyance aforesaid contained in the said indenture which is hereto
annexed and we do therefore command you that you do personally
