and hereunto an next person ally appeared before us in our Court  
aforesaid and being examined by us privately and apart from her husband  
and having the said aforesaid fully explained to her she the said Sally  
Warren acknowledged the same to be her act and deed and declared that  
she had willingly signed said and delivered the same and declared that  
we should not to retract it Given under our hands and seals this 19th  
day of June 1800

This Indenture was made by the oath of Jacob Ramsey two of the Witnesses hereto and acknowledged by House  
Sammons Party hereto together with the Certificate of Newit Harris

to Record And all a Court held for the said County of Southampton

This Indenture made this 21st day of May in the year of our Lord  
one thousand eight hundred and sixteen by Spencer Pence & Emily  
Pence his wife of the County of Norfolk and the state of Virginia of the  
one part and Richard Murphy of the County of Southampton in  
the state aforesaid of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Spencer  
Pence and Emily his wife for and in consideration of five hundred dollars  
to the said Spencer Pence in hand paid by the said Richard Murphy  
at and before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt  
whereof is hereby acknowledged they the said Spencer Pence and  
Emily his wife for themselves their heirs executors and administrators  
have granted bargained sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents  
do grant bargain sell alien and confirm unto the said Richard  
Murphy his heirs and assigns forever One undivided sixth part of an Acre  
tract or parcel of land lying in the aforesaid County of Southampton  
or black water river formerly the property of William H. Baker and  
called Little town land containing by estimation eight hundred and  
more or less together with all and singular the rights appurtenant  
emoluments to the same belonging or in any wise appertaining  
To have and to hold the said one undivided sixth part of the tract  
or parcel of land aforesaid unto the appointee an executor
