Goodwyn and Thomas Ridley Justices of the peace in the County of Southampton in the state of Virginia do hereby certify that Mary Wells the wife of James Wells parties to a certain deed for the conveyance of real estate to Frances Ridley bearing date on the 1st day of March 1816 and hereto annexed personally appeared before us in our County and being examined by us privately and apart from her husband and having the said deed before her fully explained to her she the said Mary Wells acknowledged the same to be her act and deed and declared that she had willingly signed sealed and delivered the same and that she wished not to retract it Given under our hands and seal this first day of March 1816

Wells party hereto in pursuance of an act of assembly in such case made and provided and also entered in the Clerk's office at a Court held for the County of Southampton the 19th day of August 1816 This indenture and Certificate as aforesaid was entered upon the proceedings of the day

This Indenture made this 5th day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixteen between James Gee and his wife Mary of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia of the first part and Littleberry Mason of the County of Southampton and state of North Carolina of the second part Witnesseth that the said James Gee and Mary his wife for and in consideration of the sum of four thousand one hundred and eighty dollars - two thousand and ninety dollars which are hereby acknowledged by the said James Gee and his wife Mary to have been paid to them by the said Littleberry Mason at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents one thousand and forty five dollars secured by bond bearing equal date with these presents payable on the first day of January eighteen hundred and eighteen and one thousand and forty five dollars bearing equal date with these presents payable on the first day of January eighteen hundred and nineteen have bargained sold aliened conveyed confirmed and by these presents do bargain sell alien convey and confirm unto the said Littleberry Mason one tract or parcel of land which according to the aforesaid Mary wife of the said James Gee from whom married with him one infant child of the late John A. Wilkinson and which has been allotted to the aforesaid Mary Gee by Virtue of a
