of assembly in such case made and provided.

to and twenty six cents the tax and damages on a tract of land con-
Jenkins taining thirty six acres which was returned in the name of Joseph
Twiler for the non payment of taxes thereon for the years 1808, 1809
and 1809 which said land was vested in the president and directors
of the literary fund and are hereby assumed in pursuance of an act
of assembly in such case made and provided.

to four dollars and five cents the tax and damages on a tract of land
Harrison containing 195 acres returned in the name of Henry Harris for the
non payment of the taxes thereon for the years 1798, 1799, 1800, 1801,
1802, 1803, 1804 & 1805 and the taxes and damages on a tract of
containing 125 acres returned in the name of the said Henry Harris
for the non payment of taxes thereon for the year 1806 the title
which said land became vested in the president and directors of the
literary fund and which is hereby assumed in pursuance of an act
of assembly in such case made and provided.
