This Indenture made this fifteenth day of August in the year one thousand eight hundred and seven between John Butts of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia of the one part and Benjamin Wren of the same County and state aforesaid of the other part Whereas that the said John Butts for an in Consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty pounds lawful money of this Commonwealth to him in hand paid by the said Benjamin Wren at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said Benjamin Wren his heirs and assigns one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton containing by estimation Eighty three acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a spanish oak standing near the road at corner of said land and the land of William Butts dec^d thence along said land to a cypress tree and enough thence to a red oak and thence to a red oak & fence thence to a pine & firecypress at the head of a small branch that down the said branch to the main run of the Raccoon swamp thence up the main run of said swamp to the racoon swamp bridge thence up the road to the beginning together with all woods underwoods swamps water courses profits and advantages whatever to the said land belonging or in any wise appertaining unto the said Benjamin Wren his heirs and assigns forever and the said John Butts for himself and his heirs the said tract of land with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining and the revenue and revenues and remainders unto and services thereof to the said Benjamin Wren his heirs and assigns be the only proper and lawful claim against him the said John Butts and his heirs shall and well may
