 and James Rochelle parties hereto In pursuance of an act of
 assembly in such case made and provided and as matter to record
 and at a Court for the County of Southampton the 16th day of Septem-
 ber 1816 This Indenture as aforesaid was entered upon the proceedings
 of the day — Jests James Rochelle &

This Indenture made this 7th day of September and thousand
 eight hundred and sixteen between James Rochelle of the County of
 Southampton of the first part Samuel Nicholson of the County of Kent
 and state of North Carolina of the second part and John Cricklow
 of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia of the third part
 Whereas John Cricklow by his act dated the 21st day of February 1815 and
 as matter to record in the County Court of Southampton the 2nd day of
 March 1815 in order to secure the said Samuel Nicholson a certain
 sum of money therein mentioned due and owing to the said Sam^l Nicholson
 from the said John Cricklow Conveyed in Trust to the said James
 Rochelle as trustee a certain tract or tracts parcel or parcels of land
 as expressed in said act in trust and the said sum of money having
 been satisfied and paid or otherwise secured to be paid to the said
 Samuel Nicholson in the said John Cricklow hath requested that the
 estate Conveyed by the said act in trust to the said James Rochelle in
 the said lands be now released to the said John Cricklow —

This Indenture therefore Witnesseth that for and in
 Consideration of dollar by the said John Cricklow to the said James Rochelle
 as has paid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said James
 Rochelle with the Consent of the said Samuel Nicholson signified by his
 being a party hereto have granted remise release and forever quit claim
 and by these presents solemnly and absolutely grant remise release and fore-
 quit claim unto the said John Cricklow his heirs and assigns forever all the
 estate right title interest property claim and demands whatsoever in law
 or equity of them and each of them the said James Rochelle and Samuel
 Nicholson of in and to the aforesaid tracts of land with the appurtenan-
 ces to the said John Cricklow his heirs and assigns forever so that the
 said James Rochelle and Samuel Nicholson nor either of them nor
 either heirs nor any other person whatsoever claiming under or either
 of them shall by any ways or means hereafter have claim challenge
 or demand any estate right title or interest of in or to the said premises
 or any part or parcel thereof but from all and every action for the recovery
 thereof and from all and every estate right title interest or demand of
 in or to the said premises or any part thereof they and every of them
 shall be utterly excluded and barred forever by these presents —
