 This Indenture made this 9th day of September one thousand eight
 hundred and sixteen between John Cricklow and Mary his wife of the County
 of Southampton of the one part and Benjamin Cobb of the said County of
 the other part Witnesseth that the said John Cricklow and Mary his wife
 for and in consideration of the sum of two thousand one hundred dollars current
 money to them in hand paid by the said Benjamin Cobb the receipt
 whereof the said John Cricklow and Mary his wife doth hereby acknowledge
 they the said John Cricklow and Mary his wife have granted bargained
 and sold aliened enfeoffed and by these presents do grant bargain sell
 alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said Benjamin Cobb his heirs and
 assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land containing by estimation
 three hundred acres be the same more or less purchased by Daniel Simmons
 from John Simmons and Anne his wife by Indenture bearing date the 13th
 day of January 1786 and recorded in the County Court of Southampton and
 purchased by said William Cricklow of the said Daniel Simmons by
 Indenture bearing date the 5th day of May 1786 reference being had to the
 said and the same will more fully appear and be bounded as follows -
 Beginning at a swampy place thence up the main run of the said
 swamp to the mouth of the sweat house branch to a red oak a little beyond
 the mouth thereof thence along Samuel Drewry's line to a pine in a
 small branch thence down the said branch to a gum thence along the
 do Indian line to a red oak thence along a line of new marked trees to
 the beginning and also all trees woods underwoods Commons Common of pastures
 profits Commodities advantages emoluments hereditaments whatsoever to the
 said tract or parcel of land above mentioned belonging or in any wise
 appertaining or in or upon the same growing happening or arising and
 also the reversions and reversions remainder and remainders rents & services
 of the said premises and of every part thereof and also the Estate right title
 interest claim and demand whatsoever of them the said John Cricklow
 and Mary his wife of or out to the said premises and every part thereof
 do have and to hold all and singular the premises above mentioned and
 every part thereof with the appurtenances unto the said Benjamin Cobb
