This indenture was acknowledged by John Grichlow County Clerk and a Certificate of Newton Harris and Thomas Risley Magistrates of this County Certifying the acknowledgment of Mary Grichlow the pursuance of an act of assembly in such case made and provided and as matters to record. This at a Court held for the County of Southampton the 16th day of September 1816 This Indenture and Certificate as aforesaid were entered upon the proceedings of the day

This Indenture made this 20th day of July in the year of Christ one thousand eight hundred and sixteen between William Phillips and his wife Sarah of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia of the first part and Littlebury Mason of the County of Southampton (and state of North Carolina) of the second part Witnesseth that the said William Phillips and Sarah his wife for and in Consideration of the sum of two thousand five hundred dollars have bargained sold aliened enfeoffed and Confirmed and by these presents do bargain sell alien enfeoffed and Confirmed unto the said Littlebury Mason one tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid upon Meherrin river containing sixty eight acres being a part of the land which descended to the aforesaid Sarah wife of the said William Phillips from Ann Maria Wilkinson an infant child of the late John L Wilkinson dec^d which has been allotted to the aforesaid Sarah Phillips by virtue of a decree of the County Court of Southampton and which is bounded by the lands of John Boykin to the north also the undivided third part of that tract of land of which the said John L Wilkinson dec^d was seized lying in Southampton North Carolina upon Meherrin river aforesaid which has descended to the said Sarah Phillips also one undivided third part of that portion of the same tract of land lying in Southampton County and state of Virginia which has been allotted and assigned to Ann Maria widow dec^d of the said John L Wilkinson dec^d as and for her dower which descended to the aforesaid Sarah Phillips from Ann Maria Wilkin son dec^d infant child of the said John L Wilkinson dec^d To have and to hold the aforesaid parcels of land with all the profits commodities and issues and all and singular the appurtenances
