This Indenture made this 7th day of November one
 thousand eight hundred and sixteen between James Borden and Sally his wife
 of the County of Hartford and state of North Carolina of the one part and
 Lewis Worrell of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia of the other
 part Witnesseth that the said James Borden and Sally his wife for and in
 consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars and fifty cents in hand
 paid by the said Lewis Worrell the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath
 bargained sold aliened gifted and confirmed unto the said Lewis Worrell and to
 his heirs forever one certain tract or parcel of land lying in the County of South-
 ampton Virginia and in the parish of saint Lukes containing by estimation
 seventeen hundred and more or less and bounded as followeth. Vizt
 beginning at the branch called the penny branch at a pine thence along
 that branch to a new corner made in lots N^o 4. 5 and 6 and also in the corner
 running thence along a dividing line of lot N^o 5 and 6 to a new corner post in
 a corn field a corner of lots N^o 5 6 7 and 8 thence along a new dividing line
 of lots N^o 5 & 7 to a stub a new corner made on Lewis Worrells line below his gate
 thence along Lewis Worrells out line to the first station containing seventeen and
 one half acres being lot N^o 5 in the division of Joel Edwards land by a decree
 of Southampton County Court and was allotted to James Borden in right of
 his wife late Sally Edwards daughter of said Joel To have and to hold
 the said tract and parcel of land and premises with its appurtenances unto the
 said Lewis Worrell his heirs and assigns forever to the only proper use and behoof
 of him the said Lewis Worrell his heirs and assigns forever and the said James
 Borden and Sally his wife for themselves their heirs &c doth forever warrant
 and defend the title of the same and every part thereof against all & every
 person or persons whatsoever.
