This Indenture made the 16th day of December in the year
 of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixteen by and between Jesse Story
 and Patsy Story his wife Zachariah Story and Busy Story his wife Benjamin Story
 Patsy Story his wife and Lemuel Story all of the County of Southampton and
 state of Virginia of the one part and Samuel Story of the same County and
 state of the other part Witnesses that they the said Jesse Story and Patsy his
 wife Zachariah Story and Busy his wife Benjamin Story and Patsy his wife
 and Lemuel Story for and in consideration of the sum of fifty three dollars to
 each of them the said Jesse Story Zachariah Story Benjamin Story and Lemuel
 Story in hand paid by the said Samuel Story at and before the executing and
 delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged that the said
 Jesse Story and Patsy his wife Zachariah Story and Busy his wife Benjamin
 Story and Patsy his wife and Lemuel Story for themselves their heirs executors
 and administrators have granted bargained sold aliened and confirmed and
 by these presents do grant bargain sell alien and confirm unto him the said
 Samuel Story his heirs and assigns forever four undivided fifth part of a
 certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the aforesaid County of South-
 ampton on the south side of Nottoway river and containing by estimation thirty
 six acres more or less the same being a part of the lands which was devised by
 the last will and testament of Stephen Hancock lately deceased to the above
 named Jesse Story Zachariah Story Samuel Story Benjamin Story & Lemuel
 Story in equal distributions thirty four acres thereof being a tract which was
 purchased by the said Stephen Hancock from William Vick as appears by
 a deed duly executed by the said William Vick as appears by a deed duly executed
 by the said William Vick and Abigail Vick his wife to the said Stephen Hancock
 for the same which deed bears date the third day of April one thousand seven hundred
 and ninety five and is duly recorded in the County Court of Southampton aforesaid
 the remaining two acres being adjacent to the above tract having been purchased
 by the said Stephen Hancock from John Thomas as appears by a written contract
 or obligation executed by the said Thomas to him the said Stephen Hancock for and
 containing the same bearing date the 16th day of February 1810 To have and to
 hold the said four undivided fifth parts of the tract of land aforesaid together
 with all and singular the rents issues profits and emoluments to the same belonging
 or from or out of the same in any manner growing or accruing to him the said
 Samuel Story his heirs and assigns forever and they the said Jesse Story and
 Patsy his wife Zachariah Story and Busy his wife Benjamin Story and
