March in the year 1817 and in the 48th year of the Commonwealth between Mary Darden of the County of Southampton and state of North Carolina of the one part and W^m J^r Smith of Southampton County and state of Virginia of the other part Witnesseth that the said Mary Darden in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars of lawful money of this Commonwealth to her in hand paid by the said William J^r Smith at or before the signing and delivery of these presents do bargain and sell unto the said William J^r Smith his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton in the state of Virginia adjoining the lands of Benjamin Blank sent the lands of Allen Jones and the lands of David Thomas dec^d containing by estimation one hundred and two acres more or less together with all and singular the appurtenances profits or advantages thereto belonging To have and to hold the above described land with the tenements heretofore and all and singular other the premises herein before called is to or intended to be bargained and sold with warranty and force thereof unto the said William J^r Smith his heirs and assigns forever and the said Mary Darden late Mary Thomas for herself her heirs the said within described land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances herein before mentioned unto the said William J^r Smith his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of her the said Mary Darden late Mary Thomas or her heirs executors admors or assigns and of all and every person or persons whatsoever shall well and do warrant and force defend by the presents.
