This Indenture made this the 22nd day of February one thousand eight hundred and seventeen between Benjamin Johnson of the County of Southampton of the one part and Elisha Williams of the County of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Benjamin Johnson for and in consideration of the sum of eight hundred dollars current money to him in hand paid by the said Elisha Williams at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the Benjamin Johnson doth hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit and discharge the said Elisha Williams his heirs executors and administrators forever by these presents the said Benjamin Johnson hath granted bargained sold alien released and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell alien release and confirm unto the said Elisha Williams his heirs and assigns forever one plantation parcel or tract of land situate being and lying in the County of Southampton on the North side of Barrows near the said plantation tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and forty five acres to the same more or less together with all houses out houses edifices buildings woods wares water courses waters log roads profits Commons tithes Hereditaments and appurtenances whatsoever and reversion and cursons remainder and remainders unto heirs and profits thereof and all the estate right title interest use trust possession property benefit claim and demands of the said Benjamin Johnson of unto the same any and every part thereof and all debts claims and writings touching or concerning the premises To have and to hold the said plantation tract or parcel of land premises as herein before mentioned with the appurtenances unto the said Elisha Williams his heirs and assigns to the only use and behoof of him the said Elisha Williams his heirs and assigns forever and the said Benjamin Johnson the said plantation tract or parcel of land and premises hereby bargained and sold unto the said Elisha Williams his heirs and assigns and every and all of them against them the said Benjamin Johnson and against all and every other person persons whatsoever shall and will forever defend.
