This Indenture
 bearing in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and thirty seven between George Williams of the county of Southampton and parish of the one part and Burwell Burn of the same County and parish of the other part Witnesseth that the said George Williams for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty eight shillings and pence to him in hand paid by the said Burwell Burn the receipt whereof the said George Williams doth acknowledge himself fully and amply satisfied and paid hath granted bargained sold aliened conveyed confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Burwell Burn to him and to his heirs forever one certain tract of land premises adjoining the said Burwell Burn land formerly purchased of Burn Williams containing five acres and $\frac{5}{8}$ of an acre be the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a post oak a corner of a new corner made in George Williams' line thence N 6 West 48 poles to a pole oak a corner of George Williams and Burwell Burn thence S 74 E 6 3/4 pole to the first station together with all houses out houses edifices buildings yards gardens orchards ways waters and watercourses whatsoever belonging to or in any wise appertaining to the said tract of land and premises To have and to hold the same unto the said Burwell Burn to him and to his heirs forever and the said George Williams for himself his heirs executors and assigns doth by these presents covenant and grant unto the said Burwell Burn and his heirs (firmly) and that the said George Williams with by these presents forever warrant and defend all right title claim or demands of any person or persons whatsoever claiming or demanding the same at any part thereof.
