of twenty shillings current money of Virginia paid unto the said Amos
Joyner and Nancy his wife at or before the sealing and delivery of these
premises the receipt whereof the said Amos Joyner and Nancy his wife doth
acknowledge themselves fully and amply satisfied and paid both granted given
and set over unto the said Harrison Joyner to him and to his heirs forever one
certain tract or parcel of land and premises situate lying and being in the County
aforesaid containing by estimation thirty nine acres be the same more or less
and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a white oak corner of Amos
Joyner and Schabas Johnson thence bounded by the lines of Amos Joyner
Bartholomew Bryant John Octonelys Estate lines and from thence to the first
station together with all houses out houses offices buildings yards gardens
orchards ways waters and watercourses whatsoever belonging or in any wise ap-
pertaining To have and to hold the said land unto the said Harrison Joyner
to him and to his heirs forever and the said Amos Joyner and Nancy his
wife for themselves their heirs Executors and assigns doth by these presents Covenant
and grant to and with the said Harrison Joyner his heirs and assigns that they
