 larly shew, and which said debt with legal interest thereon accruing
 to the said William Bailey is willing and desirous to secure with the
 said Stich Nicholas and for that purpose. Now this indenture witnesseth
 that for and in consideration of the premises, and also for the further con-
 sideration of one dollar lawful money of Virginia to said William
 Bailey in hand paid by the said Samuel Blunt, at and before the
 making and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowl-
 edged, that the said William Bailey hath given, granted, bargained, sold,
 aliened, conveyed, released, and confirmed, and by these presents doth
 give, grant, bargain, sell, alien, release, and confirm, unto the said
 Samuel Blunt, his heirs and assigns forever, one Negro Slave by the name
 of Thomas: to have and to hold the said granted or hereby intended to be
 granted, of our said Negro Slave by name of Doug, forever, and the said
 William Bailey for himself, his heirs, exors. admors. &c. doth hereby covenant
 promise, and agree to and with the said Samuel Blunt, his heirs &c.
 forever, in manner and form following, that is to say, that he the said
 William Bailey his heirs, exors. & admors. the aforesaid negro Slave here-
 by conveyed unto the said Samuel Blunt, his heirs &c. against all per-
 sons whatsoever shall well warrant, and forever defend by these presents.
 Upon trust nevertheless that he the said Samuel Blunt, his heirs &c. shall
 permit the said William Bailey to remain in quiet and peaceable possession
 of the said negro Slave above mentioned, hereby conveyed, and take
 the profits thereof to his own use, until default be made in the discharge
 of the said above mentioned bonds, with such interest thereon as may
 lawfully accrue, either in whole or in part, and then so soon as the
 said Samuel Blunt, his heirs &c. may think proper, or the said Stich
 Nicholas, his executor, administrator, or assigns shall request, shall sell
 the said above mentioned negro slave hereby conveyed, to the highest
 bidder for ready money at public Auction after having fixed the
 time and place of sale at their own discretion, and given thirty days
 notice of the same by advertisement to be set up at the door of the Court
 house of Southampton County, on some Court day previous to the day of
 sale, And out of the monies arising from the sale of the said above men-
 tioned negro slave, pay to the said Stich Nicholas (after having satisfied
 the charges attending such sale) his executor, administrator or assigns, the
 full amount of the said above mentioned bonds, with all lawful interest
 thereon accruing, and the balance if any shall pay to the said William
 Bailey his heirs, exors. admors. or assigns, In Witness Whereof the said parties
 to these presents, have hereunto set their hands, and affixed their seals the
 day and year first above written.
