This Indenture, made this 25th day of Decr in the year of our Lord, Christ one thousand eight hundred and sixteen Between Richard E. Williams and Patsy his Wife, of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part, and Richard Williams of the same County, and State aforesaid, of the other part. Witnesseth that the said Richard E. Williams and Patsy his wife for and in consideration of the yearly rents and covenants therein after inserted and contained, which on the part and behalf of the said Richard Williams his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns, are or ought to be paid, kept, done and performed, hath devised, granted and to have, let unto the said Richard Williams, his heirs, executors administrators and assigns, a certain piece or parcel of Land situate, lying and being in the County of Southampton, known and distinguished by the Washington hands, as reference to Josiah Vick's deed of gift to Williams and his heirs will more fully appear; also one other tract lying on the main road leading to Jerusalem, a part of the Land which the said Richard E. Williams purchased of Josiah Vick as reference to said deed; and whereunto it will be known that the above named Washington Tract was sold under a decree of the honorable Court of Southampton, subject to a power of sale, in said land which was assigned to Escher Washington at the time of the said Josiah Vick's becoming the purchaser, and will ultimately fall into the estate of the above Williams and wife, notwithstanding the said Escher Washington shall at any time, within the hereafter mentioned period of his life it is the intention of the above parties, that the said above shall be included in this bargain and sale, together with the appurtenances to the said piece of Land belonging or appertaining. To have and to hold the said piece or parcel of Land hereby devised, with the appurtenances thereto belonging, to the said Richard Williams his heirs, executors, administrators, or assigns from the 25th day of December 1816. for and during the term of five years and fully to be complete and in full; yielding and paying therefor yearly
