This Indenture, made this fifteenth day
 of March 1817 between William T. Moore & Sally, his wife of the County
 of Southampton of the one part and Robert Fort of the County of Sussex
 of the other part, Witnesseth, that for and in consideration of the sum
 of two thousand four hundred ninety one dollars and seventy five cents
 to us in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, hath granted,
 bargained, sold, & by these presents do grant, bargain, & sell, unto the said
 Robert Fort one certain tract or parcel of land, lying and being in Parish
 of St Lukes and bounded as follows to wit, beginning at a post oak
 corner of Francis Ridley, Edwin Turner and so Land thence North 45
 East 280 poles to a pine near the head of a branch, thence down S. branch
 to the Indian's branch, and down the Indian branch to a gum a corner
 corner of said Land and Abriestore Jones, thence along a line of new man
 ked South 20, West 63 poles to a red oak, thence North 76, West 33 poles
 to the dogwoods a corner of said Jones and William Thorp, the same corner
 56 poles, a new made line to a white oak made a corner in the barrens
 branch, and up the course of said branch to a maple, thence South 32
 East 126 poles to the beginning; is all four hundred ninety eight an
 quarter acres, which said Land we warrant and defend the title of the
 Fort and his heirs forever against the claim of any person whatsoever,
 In Witness whereof we set our hands and seals this day and date
 Signed, sealed, and
 delivered in presents
