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This Indenture, made this 15. day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and nineteenth, between Miles Cook of the first part, and Lawrence Cook of the second part, Witnesseth that the said Miles Cook, for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand four hundred and fourteen dollars, to the said Miles Cook in hand paid by the said Lawrence Cook, the receipt of which the said Miles Cook doth hereby acknowledge, hath bargained, sold, and confirmed, and by these presents doth bargain, sell, assign, release, and deliver unto the said Lawrence Cook his heirs and assigns, a certain tract or parcel of Land, lying and being in the County of Southampton, and containing by a late survey five hundred & six acres & the same more or less. It being the said Miles Cooks distinctable share as one of the shares of Lazarus Cook dec'd, of the Land which the said dec'd dec'd and his heirs, in the aforesaid County of Southampton and bounded as follows: Beginning at a forked poplar standing in the mill branch and a corner of John Simmons Land, and thence down Cooks down land thence along the line of marked trees N. East to a large pine a corner of Charles Bryants Land, and thence along the said down Land thence along the said Bryants line, to Giles Barretts line, thence along the said Barretts line to a double pine stump a corner in said Barretts line, thence along a line of marked trees to a three pronged black gum standing in the long branch, and a corner of the said Barretts & the lands of Long James Bryant dec'd thence down the various courses of the said branch to Simmons Mill Pond thence down the various courses of the said pond to the mouth of the mill branch and thence up the various courses of the said branch to the first station. To have and to hold the said Land and premises with all the appurtenances thereto belonging unto him the said Lawrence Cook, and to his heirs and assigns forever. And the said Miles Cook doth for himself his heirs &c. for ever warrant and defend the title of the said Land and premises against all and every person or persons who or who ever lawfully claiming the same or any part or parcel thereof.
