This Indenture, made this 24th day of February in the year of our Lord, and thousand eight hundred and seventeen, Wm Briggs, Edward Butts, & Henry Briggs of the County of Southampton Commissioners appointed by a decree of the County Court of Southampton, to make the sale of and convey in fee simple to the Church and the Land belonging to Simmons Jones dec'd in the County of Southampton, of the one part and Josiah Jones of the other part, Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred forty dollars to us in hand paid by the said Jones at or before the making and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof we do hereby acknowledge, hath this day granted, bargain and sold, and by these presents, sold, grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said Josiah Jones his heirs or assigns the several tract of Land containing fifty and 1/2 acres and bounded as follows beginning at Lightwood still standing in the corner of a corner of Jones Jones running thence south 13 degrees west 13 1/2 poles to a small gum corner of Josiah Jones standing in the Church branch, thence south 65
