This Indenture made this 31st day of January in Year of Our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and twenty four between John Carr & Mary his wife of the County of Isle of Wight, and Rebekah Carr wife of Abraham Carr of the County of Southampton of the one part and Samuel Corbitt of the County of Southampton of the other part. Witnesseth that the s^d John Carr & Mary his wife of the County of Isle of Wight aforesaid, and Rebekah Carr wife of the s^d Abraham Carr for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred and ten dollars current money of Virginia, to them in hand paid by the s^d Samuel Corbitt, the receipt whereof the s^d John Carr & Mary his wife, and Rebekah Carr wife of Abraham Carr doth acknowledge themselves fully and amply satisfied and paid, hath, granted, bargained, sold, aliened, enfeoffed, and confirmed, and by these presents doth grant, bargain and sell unto the said Samuel Corbitt his heirs and assigns forever, one certain tract or parcel of Land and premises, adjoining the s^d Abraham Carr and Mary White, being a point of the said Land and premises of the said Abraham Carr now lies containing by a late survey made by the County surveyor of Southampton County three acres to the same more or less, and bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning at a small sapling as a new Corner made on the side of Blackwater River, in the s^d Carrs land, thence to 41. N. 50 poles to a small scrub oak (marked) on the river, thence N. 7. W. 90 poles to a small black gum a new corner made, on the side of the Run of no head swamp thence along the said Swamp to the various corners thereof
