Whereas Robert Locke, late of the County of Surrey, died seized in fee of a certain tract or parcel of land situate in the County of Southampton, called and known by the name of Locke's plantations - and whereas the said Robert Locke died intestate, leaving an infant daughter Martha R. Locke, his only child, and heirs of his estate; and whereas the said Martha R. Locke afterwards intermarried with Bartholomew D. Menley, and hath since died under the age of twenty one year, and without issue, and whereas in consequence thereof the said tract or parcel of land, according to the wish of the said Martha, Mary Keenon Faulconer, wife of John Faulconer of the aforesaid County of Surrey, hath become entitled, to a certain undivided proportion, or interest therein. Now this Indenture made this third day of January in the year of Christ one thousand eight hundred and fifty between the said John Faulconer and Mary R. his wife of the one part, and Simon Boykin of the County of Southampton, of the other part. Witness that the said John Faulconer and Mary R. his wife, in consideration of the sum of one hundred and forty dollars to them in hand paid by the said Simon Boykin, at and before the execution and delivery of these presents, did accept thereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained and sold
