This Indenture

made this 29th day
 of July 1816, between Henry Welsh and Sophia J. his
 wife of the County of Southampton, and estate of single
 men, of the one part, and William E. Daughtry of the
 same County of the other part. Witnesseth that the said
 Henry Welsh, and Sophia J. his wife, for and in consider-
 ation of the sum of Twenty five hundred dollars to them in
 hand paid by the said William E. Daughtry, the receipt
 whereof they do hereby acknowledge, and of acquit
 acquit and discharge the said William E. Daughtry, his
 heirs, executors and administrators, have granted, bargained
 and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain
 and sell, unto him the said William E. Daughtry one
 piece, parcel or lot of Land, with all singular buildings
 thereon, which said lot contains two acres, to the same more
 or less, and bounded as follows (to wit) Beginning on the
 west side of the road at the main street in Southampton pa-
 rallel with the corner of lot N^o 1, thence to the corner of
 lot N^o 1, thence along the said lot N^o 1, 70. 00 pole to the
 river, thence N 23 W 21 pole up the river bank to a corner
 post, thence N 65, 34, E. 46 pole to a corner post on the
 west side of the road, thence S 16. E 21 pole to the first
 station, to comprehend two complete acres, together with all
 profits, commons, tithes, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the
 same belonging, or in any wise appertaining, and the rents
 and reversions, remainders and reversionaries, Rents, issues
 and services thereof and every part and parcel thereof
 To have, and to hold, all and singular the premises
 before mentioned to the said William E. Daughtry, his
 heirs and assigns, to the only proper use of the said William
 E. Daughtry, his heirs and assigns forever, and they the said
 Henry Welsh and Sophia J. his wife, for themselves their
 heirs executors and administrators, promise, covenant and
 agree to and with the said William E. Daughtry, his
 heirs, executors and assigns, that they will warrant
 and defend the title to the aforesaid Land and premises
