This Indenture, made this twenty fifth
day of February, and thousand eight hundred and seventeen
between James Millar Junr of the one part, and Denny Waller
of the other part, both of the County of Southampton and state
of Virginia, Witnesses, that the said James Millar Junr for
and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and ninety
and dollars and eighty eight cent, to him in hand paid by
the said Denny Waller, at and before the sealing and delivery
of these presents, the receipt whereof he hereby acknowledges, he
granted, bargained, sold, aliened, and confirmed, (and of these presents
he grant, bargain, sell, alien, enfeoff and confirm, unto him the
said Denny Waller his heirs and assigns forever, one certain
tract or parcel of Land situate, lying and being in the County
of Southampton and state of Virginia, And bounded
as follows, beginning at the intersection of a small branch
and the North Branch of Buchanan swamp, a corner of Parker
and Edmunds land, thence N 24 d. E 40 poles, thence N 67 d. E 40 poles
to a white oak, thence S 85 d. E 14 poles, thence N 35 d. E 48 poles,
to a red oak a corner of Benj. Barham's land, thence S 15 d. W 100
poles, to a small black oak a new corner in James Millar's line
thence S 47 d. W 50 poles to a black gum a new corner in Parker
and Edmunds line, in a small branch, thence down the various
courses of the said branch, to the first station, containing fifty
poles to the same more or less. To have and to hold the
said fifty two acres of land, with all and singular the
appurtenances therunto belonging, to the said Denny Waller his
heirs and assigns forever, to the only proper use and behoof of
the said Denny Waller his heirs and assigns, and the said James
