day of June, in the year and thousand eight hundred and seventeen between James Wells a downright the will annexed of William Blinn dec'd of the one part and James Trepant of the other part, Whereas the said William Blinn of the County of Southampton by his last will testament, among other things directed that his executors should sell the tract of land whereon he lived & for this Indenture witnesseth that the said James Wells doth with the will annexed of the s^d William Blinn for and in consideration of the sum of four thousand seven hundred and eight dollars & 9 cts. As him in hand paid at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents by the said James Trepant, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, he hath granted, bargained, sold, aliened, released & confirmed, and by these presents doth grant, bargain sell, alien, release & confirm unto the said James Trepant, the following lots & parcels of land, situate, lying & being in the County of Southampton on the south side of the Rotterdam River near the Town of Jerusalem and which said several lots & parcels of land compose the said tract directed to be sold by the s^d Wm Blinn, and which said lots & parcels of land are described and numbered as followeth in the report of the commissioners acting under a decree of the Chancellor of the said County in the division of the lands of Benjamin Edwards dec'd, West lot No 6, which the said Wm Blinn
