1817, in the year of our Lord, Christ one thousand eight hundred
and seventeen between Henry Council, Ealey Council & Nancy
Council, Children of Esq^r Council all of the County of
Southampton & State of Virginia of the one part, and Ealey
Soyner of the same County and State of the other part, Witness
that at the said Ealey Henry Council, Ealey Council &
Nancy Council, Children of Esq^r Council, for and in con-
sideration of the sum of thirty dollars, good and lawful
money of Virginia to them in hand and paid by the said Ealey
Soyner the receipt whereof the said Henry Council, Ealey Council
& Nancy Council doth acknowledge themselves fully & amply
satisfied and paid, having granted, bargained, sold, aliened
conveyed & confirmed, and by their presents doth grant, bargain
and sell unto the said Ealey Soyner, to him and to his heirs
forever all the right, interest, claim or demand whatsoever
of them the s^d Henry Council, Ealey Council, & Nancy Council
which or ever will stand both in Law or in equity in all the
lands of Rich^d Warrell dec^d which they suppose to be to
their part 2 1/2 acres to the same more or less, together with
all the profits, rents, issues, &c thereof belonging or in any
