I, Jacob Darden of Southampton County, Virginia, for and
in consideration of the paternal love and respect which
I have and do bear towards my son Joseph Darden of the
said county, have granted and do loan to my said son Joseph
Darden for the space of five years, from the date of these
presents, one Negro girl named Mairida, whom I have
to hold the said girl Mairida to him the said Joseph
Darden, for and during the term aforesaid, and then to
be returned and given up to me or my heirs or assigns.

hereunto set my hand and seal this 29th day of April 1817.
