We James Clayton & Benjamin Griffin Justices of the Peace in the County aforesaid and in the State of Virginia, do hereby certify that Elizabeth Beal the wife of Jordan Beal parties to a certain deed for the conveyance of land situate in Henry County, bearing date 15th day of March 1817, and being personally appeared before us in our County aforesaid and being examined by us privately and apart from her husband and having the deed aforesaid fully explained to her, she the said Elizabeth Beal acknowledged the same to be her act and deed and did and that she had willingly signed, sealed and delivered the same and that she wished not to retract it. Given under our hands this 10th day of March 1817.
