This Indenture made this tenth day of
June, in the year of our Lord, eighteen hundred and seventeenth,
between Samuel Whitfield and Elizabeth his wife and George
Wilson and Mary his wife of the Parish of Smithfield in the
County of Isle of Wight of the one part, and Robert Adams
of the County of Hampshire of the other part: Witnesseth that
the said Samuel Whitfield and Elizabeth his wife, and George
Wilson and Mary his wife, for and in consideration of the sum
of seven hundred dollars, the sum in hand paid or secured to
be paid by the said Robert Adams, at or before the executing
and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknow-
ledged, have bargained and sold, and by these presents do
bargain and sell unto the said Robert Adams a certain tract
or parcel of land, lying and being in the County of Southampton
just above the bar of the creek bridge, it being all the land
which John Wright late of the County of Southampton, died
seized and possessed of, which said land was sold by a decree
of the County Court of Southampton, and William Boykin
became the purchaser, and gave the said land to his grand
daughter, Elizabeth and all my heirs, (and claiming by estimation
and hundred and eighty acres, be the same more or less, the bounds
of which may be found by a reference to the Deed from the
Commissionary appointed by the Court, to sell the said
lands, together with all and singular the appurtenances
thereunto belonging, and the reversions and reversionaries, rents and
remainders, issues and profits thereof, and of every part
