This Indenture made this twenty fifth
 day of June in the year of our Lord, and thousand eight hundred
 and seventeen, between Charles Sunnings of the County of Southamp-
 ton and State of Virginia of the one part, and Peter Blon
 of the County and State aforesaid, of the other part, Witnesseth
 that the said Charles Sunnings for and in consideration of
 the sum of five hundred and forty dollars, to him in hand
 paid by the said Peter Blon, the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged, hath granted, bargained and sold, and
 by these presents doth grant, bargain and sell and confirm
 unto the said Peter Blon, a certain tract of land, situate,
 lying and being in the County of Southampton, containing
 hundred and twenty acres and a half or thereabouts, more or less,
 and is bounded as follows (To wit) on the east
 by the lands of Benj. Lewis, on the North by the lands of
 Peter Blon, on the south to west by the lands formerly
 of Henry Taylor (now the lower lands of his wife who intermar-
 ried with John Busham) being the same lands purcha-
 sed by Charles Sunnings of John Stites and Nancy his
 wife, &c. and he doth hereby certify that the fifteenth day of Janu-
 ary one thousand eight hundred and sixteen and recor-
 ded in the County Court of Southampton; To have and
 to hold unto the said Peter Blon his heirs and assigns for-
 ever, and the said Charles Sunnings for himself the said
 land and premises and every part thereof against himself,
 his heirs, and against all and every person or persons what-
 soever: shall and will warrant, defend and hold unto the
 said Peter Blon his heirs and assigns forever. In witness
 whereof the said Charles Sunnings hath hereunto set
 his hand and affixed his seal the day above written.
