This Indenture, made this 20th day of
 Oct in the year of our Lord, Christ, one thousand eight hundred
 and seventeen, between Arthur Vick and Nancy Vick formerly
 Nancy Rees of the state of North Carolina of the one part
 and Joseph Rees of the state of Virginia and County of
 Southampton in the Parish of Saint Luke of the other part
 Witnesses, that the said Arthur Vick and Nancy his
 wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One hundred
 and fifty dollars to them in hand paid by the said
 Joseph Rees, the receipt whereof the said Arthur Vick
 and Nancy his wife doth acknowledge themselves fully
 and amply satisfied and paid, he doth granted, sold, given
 and sold, conveyed and confirmed, and by these presents
 doth grant, sell, give and sell unto the said Joseph
 Rees his heirs and assigns forever, her proportionable part
 including the said lands corner right and certain tract or
 parcel of land and premises situated lying and being in
 the County of Southampton and State of N.C., and in the Parish
 aforesaid, containing by estimation and bounded upon
 thirty six acres, to the same more and bounded by the lines
 of the road known by the name of the land
 and fields, and to the by Little Plowman and [unclear]
 and West and Thomas Applewhite line, and East by the
 lines of the Estate line of John Rees dead to be held with
 all houses, out houses, edifices, buildings, yards, gardens, orchards
 may, meadows and water courses, whatevers belonging or in
 anywise appertaining; To have and to hold the same unto
 the said Joseph Rees and his heirs and assigns the said Arthur
 Vick and Nancy his wife for themselves their heirs &c. with
 by these presents to warrant and forever defend all rights
 titles, claims or demands, of any person or persons claiming
 or demanding the same or any part or parcel thereof. In
