wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of  
the one part, and Ann Robinson of the same County and  
State of the other part, Witnesses, that for and in consideration  
of the sum of Eleven hundred and forty five dollars, to them in  
hand paid by the said Ann Robinson, they the said Samuel  
Jones and Elizabeth his wife, have granted, bargained and  
sold, and do hereby present grant, bargain and sell unto the  
said Ann Robinson and her heirs forever and certain part or parcel  
of and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton  
and bounded as follows (To wit) beginning at a pine acorn  
tree in Bonito line, thence along said Bonito line, to Bullies
