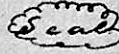
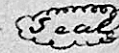


Southampton County To wit: Mrs James Clayton & Benjamin Griffin Justices of the peace in the County of Southampton aforesaid in the State of Virginia do hereby certify that Elizabeth Griffin the wife of Michael Griffin parties to the within Indenture for the conveyance of real estate to Benjamin Brister, bearing date the 1st day of June 1808 personally appeared before us in our County aforesaid and being examined by us privately and apart from her husband, and having she did aforesaid fully explained to her, she the said Elizabeth Griffin acknowledged the same to be her act and deed, and she did and that she had willingly signed, sealed and delivered the same, and that she wished not to retract it - Given under our hands the 18th day of July 1817.

At a Court held for the County of Southampton the day of Augt 1808.

This Indenture was acknowledged by Mike Griffin and continued, and together with the certificate of James Clayton and Benjamin Griffin, dated the 18th of July 1817 certifying the free examination and acknowledgment of the said Elizabeth Griffin wife of the said Mike Griffin, being returned, was admitted to record; And at a Court held for the said County of Southampton the 18th of Augt 1817 This Indenture as aforesaid was entered upon the proceedings of the day.
