this indenture made between John Braxwell
and Sally Braxwell his wife formerly Sally Williams, late
of the County of Nash and State of North Carolina
and part and Henry Welch of the County of Albemarle
and State of Virginia of the other part. Witnesseth
that the said John Braxwell Sally his wife for and in con-
sideration of the sum of three hundred thirty five dollars
good and lawful money of Virginia to them in hand paid
by the said Henry Welch the receipt whereof the said John
Braxwell & Sally his wife both acknowledge them to be fully
and amply satisfied and paid, have granted, bargained,
sold, aliened, enfeoffed and confirmed, and by these presents
doth grant, bargain & sell unto the said Henry Welch to him
and to his heirs forever, and certain tract or parcel of land
premises known by the Pecoron tract formerly belonging to
Egbert Williams dec'd. containing by a late survey made by
the surveyor of Sp. Amptons County, and run two and fifty
seven acres and an half but the same more or less unto
be run and as follows (To Wit) beginning at a pine in
William Williams dec'd. line; running thence N 18° West
159 poles to a pine a corner in William Williams estate line
thence South 59° West 20 poles to the corner of Thomas Jones
line, thence E 80. 10 20 poles variations thence S 57.
West 200 poles to a variation on Thomas Jones' and James
Bells Estate lines; thence S 59. West 8 poles to a red oak
a corner of Braxwell Williams, Thomas Jones and James
Bells Estate standing near the road leading from
Jerusalem to Smithfield; thence S 53. E 44 poles; thence S
73. E 136 poles to a pine a S of John Bottoms dec'd near his
farm in the Pecoron thence N 74. E 88 poles to the bar oppo-
site the House of the said Bottoms thence N 84. E 20 poles to a
pine a corner of John Bottoms estate land standing in a
small parcel; thence S 50. E 34 poles, thence S 7. E 38 poles to
the intersection of the two branches, and thence N 32. E 4
poles, and from thence a straight line to the first station;
