Know all men by these presents, that I Nancy Barrett of the County of Southampton, for and in consideration of the natural love and affection which I bear to my daughter Peggy Barrett of the said County of Southampton, as well for the further consideration of her poll taxes in hand paid, by the said Peggy Barrett at or before the execution and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have given and granted, and by these presents do give and grant unto the said Peggy Barrett her executor, administrator and assigns and Negro Woman named Lucy, and her one side Saddle, whomever she arrives to the age of twenty one years or marries, unto her the said Peggy Barrett her exec. admor. and assigns forever. And the said Nancy Barrett for herself her exec. and admor. the said property as aforesaid unto the said Peggy Barrett her exec. admor. & assigns, against the claims of her the said Nancy Barrett her exec. and admor. and against the claims or claims of all and every persons or persons who shall and will warrant and foreclose defend them by these presents. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 18th day of October 1817.
