This Indenture made this 19th day of July One thousand eight hundred and twenty, between John Wormack of the said County of Virginia of the one part, and John Thomas of the said County of the other part, Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by the said John Wormack, the said John Thomas, Esq. and conveyed unto him the said John Wormack, I him, Esq. and assigns forever, all my right title and claim or Interest in and unto tract or parcel of Land, which was last bequeathed unto my Wife Nancy Smith by James R. Wormack his in his last Will & Testament, found and as follows Beginning at Dick's Bridge on the road in Benj. Whents line, then a line to the Mill pond, then up the Mill pond to William Poells line, then a line to John Wormack's line, then his line to the first station, containing by estimation one hundred and eighty eight acres of Land, to the same more or less. To have and to hold the above premises with all privileges appertaining thereto unto the said John Wormack, his heirs, Esq. and assigns, And I the said Solomon Smith for myself my heirs, Esq. and assigns, do hereby warrant and defend the right and title unto the above said John Wormack his heirs, Esq. and assigns. And do acknowledge that for myself my heirs, Esq. and assigns am fully satisfied for the same.
