

and Mary, and his heirs forever, but in case he should die before
 he arrived to the age of twenty and years, and during the lifetime of Samuel
 Brown the eldest Son of the said Benjamin and Mary then to the
 use and behoof of the said Samuel and his heirs forever, provided,
 nevertheless, that in case the said Samuel should die before he
 attained the age of twenty and years, then the same should be and
 accrue to the use of Patsy, Hannah and Lucy Brown daughters
 of the said Benjamin and Mary, or such of them as should
 then be living, and their heirs, to be equally divided among them
 (if more than one should be living) shares and shares alike, and
 where as the said Mary Mason Brown departed this life soon
 after the execution of the deed aforesaid, and the said William
 H. Brown has lately, to wit, on or about the second day of
 July in the year of Christ, and there and eight hundred and
 eighty six attained the age of Twenty and years, and where as the
 said Benjamin E. Brown is desirous to release and convey unto his said
 son William H. Brown all his right and interest in and to the
 Land and Mill aforesaid, and that the said Edward Faulcon
 should also release his title as trustee to the same. Now this Indenture
 made the twenty fifth day of November, in the year of Christ
 and the year of eight hundred and eighty six, between Benjamin
 E. Brown and Edward Faulcon, Trustees as aforesaid, of the County
 of Linn, of the one part, and William H. Brown of the County
 of Linn, of the other part, Witnesses, that the said Benj
 E. Brown, and the said Edward Faulcon, as trustees aforesaid for
 and in consideration of one dollar to them then in hand paid
 by the said William H. Brown, the receipt whereof is hereby
 acknowledged, have and each of them have released, remised,
 and surrendered, and by these presents do and each of them do
 release, remise and surrender, fully and absolutely unto the said Wil-
 liam H. Brown his heirs and assigns forever all the estate,
 right, title, trust, claim and demand whatsoever, which
 they respectively have or may have in or to the Land and
 Mill, and their appurtenances contained and mentioned
 in the deed above referred to. In testimony whereof the said
 Benjamin E. Brown and Edward Faulcon as trustees aforesaid
 have hereunto set their hands and seals this twenty
 fifth day of November in the year of Christ, and thousand
 eight hundred and eighty six.
