5th day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventeen, Between Daniel Wood of the County of Southampton of the first part, Edward Butts of the same County of the second part, and Thomas Gray of the same County of the third part, Witnesseth, that whereas the said Daniel Wood at an debt justly in debt to the said Thomas Gray in the just and full sum of Eleven dollars and sixteen cents by note of hand bearing date the twenty third day of June one thousand eight hundred and seventeen, also the sum of twenty one dollar and fifty one cents, for cash advanced and account also the said Daniel Wood stands bound as security for the payment of a bond due from Mary Wood to the said Thomas Gray bearing date the 23rd day of June 1817. which by the present the said Daniel Wood acknowledged to be justly due to the said Thomas Gray for the sum of one hundred and twenty dollars & six cents, and does by these presents assign the payment and release of the said Thomas Gray stand bound with Mary Wood, and the said Daniel Wood in a joint
