Know all men by these presents that I Betsey Alberts of the County of Southampton Wife of Lewis Alberts of the same County by virtue of the power hereto vested by a marriage agreement entered into between myself and the said Lewis Alberts for and in consideration of the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars to me in hand paid by Daniel Butts before the signing and delivery of these presents, have granted, bargained, sold and delivered, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and deliver unto the said Daniel Butts his heirs and assigns forever the following negro Slaves to wit Harrison, then person Schmitts; To have and to hold the aforesaid Slaves to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Daniel Butts his heirs and assigns forever, and I the said Betsey Alberts do hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Daniel Butts that I will forever warrant and defend the right and title in and to the aforesaid Slaves to the said Daniel Butts his heirs and assigns against the claims or demands of all and every person whatsoever.
