Seventy five acres to the said more or less, together with all
reversions, remeinders, rents, profits, services & appurtenances of the
said Land & premises, every part or parcel thereof, & the
right, title, interest, claim & demand whatsoever of the
aforesaid Commissioners of in & to the said Land and premises
& every part or parcel thereof, to have & to hold the said Land
& premises, with the appurtenances unto the said Edwin Barnes
his heirs & assigns forever & the s^d Barnes for themselves as heirs
do claim and the said Land and premises every part or
