 part, and David Boggie of the County of Wight of the other  
 part, Witnesses, that the said Benj. Wilson and Martha  
 his Wife for and in consideration of the sum of Six hundred  
 dollars current money of Virginia the then in hand paid  
 at the making of these presents the receipt whereof they  
 do hereby acknowledge, fully and amply satisfied and paid,  
 have bargained, sold, aliened, and by these presents do  
 grant, bargain and sell unto David Boggie his heirs &  
 assigns forever, a certain Tract or parcel of Land lying and  
 being in the aforesaid County, containing by estimation fifty  
 four shalf Acres, to the same more or less and bounded as  
 follows, Beginning at a White oak standing in the Dam  
 branch, thence a line of marked trees running north to the  
 long branch to a black gum a corner tree thence down  
 the said branch to the mouth of the dam branch, thence  
 up the said branch to the first station, the said place  
 station, tract or parcel of Land to the use and proper use  
 and behoof of the said David Boggie, his heirs, executors, admors  
 and assigns forever, with all the Houses, out Houses, edifices
