This Indenture made the fourteenth
 day of January, in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred &
 eight, between Thomas Dunn & Polly his wife of the County of Franklin
 in the State of North Carolina of the part, and Benjamin A. Barham
 of the County of Wake, and State of North Carolina of the other
 part; Witnesseth, that the said Thomas Dunn & Polly his wife for
 in consideration of the sum of Two hundred dollars, to them in hand
 paid by the said Benjamin Barham, the receipt whereof the said
 Thomas Dunn & Polly his wife doth hereby acknowledge, hath given
 granted, bargained & sold, aliened & confirmed by these presents, doth
 give, grant, bargain & sell, alien & confirm unto the said Benjamin
 A. Barham, his heirs & assigns forever, all that tract of Land situate
 at, lying & being in the County of Southampton & State of Virginia
 it being one fourth part of a certain tract of Land, whereon Ben^y
 Barham Senr. now lives, lying on the North side of Buckhorn Creek
 adjoining the lands of Samuel Blunt, Peter Blor, Henry Waller &
 others, which said fourth part contains one hundred acres, more
 or less, it being their proportionable part of the Land conveyed to them
 by Alexander Murray dec^d of said County of Southampton, and also
 all the woods, mays, meadows & other contents, and all fees, the appurtenances
 thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining, and the revenues &
 revenues, remainder from duties, rents, issues & profits of the aforesaid
 Land & premises, every part thereof & all the estate, right, title interest
 claim, property and demand and whatsoever of the said Thos. Dunn
 his wife, of in & to the Land & premises hereby granted; To have
 and to hold, the aforesaid Land & premises, with the appurtenances,
