that the said Johnson Williford for full consideration of the sum
Six hundred fifty five Dollars twenty Cents as well appeared by re-
ceipt to the said Williford given to the said Edm Bailey bearing date June
20th 1817. & one dollar by the said Alfred S. Bailey to him in hand paid
The receipt whereof by both parties duly acknowledged, & to have the pay-
ment thereof to the said Edm Bailey, the said Johnson Williford
has granted, bargained, sold, aliened, conveyed & confirmed, & doth
by these presents grant, bargain, sell, alien, convey & confirm unto the
Sd Alfred S. Bailey his heirs, Exors. & admors all my land lying in
the County of Southampton, containing fifty five acres more or
less, To wit: One hundred twenty three acres, lying on the North side
of Tarrispin Swamp, adjoining the land of Miles Delk & black
water swamp, and one hundred & thirty three acres, whereon I now
live on the south of Tarrispin Swamp, adjoining the land of Bird
Hamill, & Joshua Pettor to have & to hold the said two hundred &
fifty five acres of land with all its appurtenances, unto the said
Alfred S. Bailey his heirs, Exors. & admors. to his & their own proper use
& behoof forever, No trust, nor help for the special purpose,
