the same County State of the other part, Witnesseth, that the said
Joseph Bracy & Sally his wife, in consideration of nine hundred
thirty six Dollars of lawful money of this Commonwealth, to them
in hand paid at or before the date above & delivery of this present
the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged & received, have bargained &
sold, by these presents do bargain & sell unto the said Jeremiah E.
Edwards his heirs & assigns a certain tract or parcel of land situated
lying & being in the County of Orange & in Northway Parish contain-
ing by estimation or hundred & forty four acres, to the same
more or less bounded as follows, to wit, by the Lands of Matthew
Mountford, Inc. Moore, Polly Barnes & Burg. (Hines), also by James
Scott Mills pond & northern swamp, By reference to the deed from
the Commissioners appointed to sell the said land under a decree of the
said Court to satisfy James Scott, the boundaries of said land
shd. shd. will more fully appear, together with all & singular the premises
& Remainder, remainders from all & every other right, issue shd. property
thereof, & of every part & parcel thereof. To have & to hold the said one
hundred & forty four acres of Land with the tenements, hereditaments
& all & singular other the premises herein before mentioned, or intended
to be bargained & sold & every part & parcel thereof with
every of their rights, members & appurtenances unto the said Jeremiah
E. Edwards his heirs & assigns forever, & the said Joseph Bracy & Sally
