 day of February one thousand eight hundred and eighteenth between Jesse  
 D. Deal and Marguerite of the one part and William Newton of the  
 other part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia  
 Witnesseth that the said Jesse D. Deal and Marguerite his wife hath  
 for and in consideration of the sum of seven hundred and seventy five  
 dollars to him in hand paid by the said William Newton or certain to be  
 paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged and himself therein  
 satisfied, contented and paid and do sherriff acquit and discharge the  
 said William Newton his heirs and assigns forever, hath granted, bargained  
 and sold confirmed and delivered and by these presents, do grant, bargain and  
 sell, release confirm and deliver unto him the said William Newton and to  
 his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract of land containing by estimation  
 one hundred and thirty five acres, be the same more or less, situate lying  
 and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid and bounded by the known  
 boundaries and standing lines of the tract of land that the said William  
 Whitehead do<sup>r</sup> purchase of John Kinard reference being had to said  
 Hundred Book will make the same more fully appear for or behalf  
 of his son Richard Whitehead and bounded on one side by a water course  
 called the little swamp and by the said Richard brought into Holckers  
 with the other lands of the said decedent and all the right title and  
 claim of him the said Jesse D. Deal and Marguerite his wife to the  
 aforesaid William Newton **To have and to hold.**

The said tract of land and premises unto him the said William  
 Newton and to his heirs and assigns forever and the said Jesse D. Deal for  
 himself his heirs and assigns doth covenant and agree with the said  
 William Newton and his heirs that he will at this time and at all times  
 hereafter warrant and defend a good and indefeasible title in fee simple to  
 the same against himself and his heirs and against all other persons
