 D. Beale as well during his life time as after his death and for and in
 consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said
 William Norton at and before the making and delivery of these presents
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said D. Beale
 hath granted, bargained, sold, aliened, conveyed and confirmed and by these
 presents doth grant, bargain, sell, alien, convey and confirm unto the said
 William Norton all that parcel or tract of land lying near to the crop
 Keys in the county aforesaid containing more or less and bounded
 by the lands of Patty Channell, Burrell Bryant and the said D. Beale
 being the same tract or parcel of land purchased by the said D. Beale
 of Britton Bryant, John Whitehead and William Phillips com-
 missioners acting under a decree of Southampton County court and
 the reversions and reversions, remainder and remainders, rents and other
 rents, issues and profits thereof and of every part and parcel thereof
 and also all the estate, right, title, interest, trust, property, claim and
