 Indenture bearing date the fifth day of July one thousand eight
 hundred and fifteen and recorded in the clerk office between Elizabeth
 Vick of the county of Southampton and state of Virginia of the one
 part and John Urquhart and George Gurley exec of Josiah Vick
 dec^d of the said county of Southampton and Wm S. Hite of the county
 of Lunenburg of the second part and Joshua Fort of the town of Granahan
 of the third part. Witnesseth that wherby the said Elizabeth Vick
 stands justly indebted to the said John Urquhart & George Gurley
 of Josiah Vick d. & and William S. Hite is the several items therein
 mentioned in said dec^d of trust and being willing and desirous to seem
 to them the payment of the same with interest and costs the said
 Elizabeth Vick hath made over conveyed and confirmed unto Joshua
 Fort Trustee for the parties the following property to wit Negro man
 Charly, who was hundred acres of land more or less with the appurtenances
 thereto belonging and three other slaves to wit Jacob George and Peter
 as referenced to said dec^d will fully explain now this Indenture
 witnesseth that I the said John Hitchin admin of Joshua Fort
