This Indenture

made this 1st day of Decem^r in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventeen between Bapite M Calvert of the county of Elizabeth City of the one part and Samuel Calvert of the Town of Smithfield and County of Isle of Wight of the other part. Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of Two hundred dollars to him the said Bapite M Calvert in hand paid by the said Samuel Calvert at or before the making and delivery of this present receipt whereof the said Bapite M Calvert doth hereby acknowledge hath grown to him in and by the said Samuel Calvert his heirs and assigns forever all his right title interest claim and demand off the said to one certain undivided tract or parcel of land situated lying and being in the county of Southampton containing two hundred and seventy six and one half acres be the same more or less which said land was purchased by Samuel Calvert of a certain Richard Vick reference being thereto had with made make the same more fully appear the said Bapite M Calvert hereunto entitled he by the death of his father the said Samuel Calvert of To have used to hold the said land and all its appurtenances unto the said Samuel Calvert his heirs assigns forever and the said Bapite M Calvert doth by these presents forever warrant and defend the title to the said tract or parcel of land and all the appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said full power and legal authority to make a conveyance of the same and do also warrant and defend from any person or persons claiming or demanding the same or any part or parcel thereof. Witnesseth that the said Silas Beal for and in consideration of the just and full sum of one hundred and thirty nine Dollars & 07 cents present money of Virginia by the said Willis Johnson to him in hand paid the receipt whereof the said Silas Beal doth hereby acknowledge and thereof acquit and is charged the said Willis Johnson his heirs and assigns forever and himself therein fully and entirely satisfied contented
